Practical Tips for Praying with Children

Do's:

- 1. Always come ready to minister in the altar.
- 2. Approach the child with gentleness.
- 3. Talk to the child before praying with them.
- 4. Ask Jesus to draw them unto himself.
- 5. Instruct and encourage the child to repent.
- 6. Believe Jesus for results!
- 7. Ask the child if he hears himself speaking in tongues.
- 8. Enter into a time of thanksgiving with the child.
- 9. Re-affirm what happened to the child before he leaves.
- 10.Discuss baptism with the child.

Don'ts:

- 1. Do not assume the child came to pray for the Holy Ghost.
- 2. Do not touch the child except for an anointed touch!
- 3. Don't expect children to talk in tongues like an adult.
- 4. Never walk away from a child without talking with them.
- 5. Don't let them seek too long.
- 6. Do not doubt that Jesus wants to use YOU!
- 7. Remember, whatever ground was covered, was a great Victory! This is about eternity!
